Call to Order

Minutes of February 11, 2025 Public Works were reviewed and approved.

Equipment Updates – The 550 Dump truck and the Freightliner were in the shop for repairs.

Infrastructure

Greenway Cemetery annual Make-It-Shine is scheduled for April 2 (rain date – April 12)
A discussion about mowing the cemetery with part-time employees and the equipment required was held. Management will be a challenge due to scheduling part-time employees.

Streetscape Committee is exploring replacement of cobra high pressure sodium street lights with LEDs.

Paving quotes are being obtained for Warren Street and the area around the German Cemetery. Emergency pothole treatment is needed for Biser Street and Mercer Street. Holes for the Handicap sign is being drilled by First Fruits. Other worn signs will be replaced.

Depot bricks are being used for the Berkeley Springs State Park patio by the fountain (funded by the Park Foundation) and for the German Cemetery path being funded by Foxglove Garden Club.


Finances

It was agreed that additional string trimmers, gas cans, and safety equipment needed to be purchased for mowing. A new tarp is needed to protect the salt pile.

Street and Refuse Accounts were reviewed and a draft FY 26 budget was discussed for presentation to the council in March.
