4. Project update review of currently awarded grants
 - A. Streetscape: Presentation by Pete Brown with update on DOH funding
 - Phase V construction contract –
 - WVDOH TA Grant Phase VI design grant – still waiting on receipt of the final Funding Agreement from DOH.

 - E. SHPO Remembrance grant - All work was completed in early June and a final report and request for reimbursement will be submitted to SHPO.
 - F. COPS grant - the use of these funds is on hold until the Town hires a second full-time police officer. Grant progress report submitted April 30.
 - G. Appalachian Forest grant – The Lovely Pixels team is on schedule to complete their work on the Town website renovation and upgrades in late July.
 - H. Mill Group grant – on June 17, 2025, the Town of Bath was awarded a pro bono contract from the Mills Group for design services.
5. Status update on other grant prospects:
 - Pending grants with Region 9 – GIS mapping grant being prepared by Region 9 for submission in July that requires a 25% funding match from BSWW.
 - An application for \$1,000,000 in Congressionally Directed Spending grant funds from Senator Shelley Moore Capito was submitted on April 22. A follow up request was received to submit a Letter of Interest.
 - Grant application for police department computers from the WV Dept. of Homeland Security submitted. Notification of awards is scheduled for July.
 - Grants for street cameras and traffic calming signs are being researched.
 - Grants for the OnTrac/Main Street program are being researched.
 - Additional grants for water facility restoration and repair are being researched. Grant applications will be submitted once the Professional Engineering Report (PER) is completed later this summer.
