Street Lights (this actually discussed first)
LED test Lights were installed: a 50 at Hunters' Hardware and a 90 at the intersection of Rt. 9 and 522 (by 7-11, but on the NE corner. PW Committee members are going to check these out over the next week. We will schedule a night to make a list of what we want for street lights throughout the entire town of Bath. This information will be forwarded to Tim Boyer of PE, who will install the new LED lights. Total range of lamps: 50-90-130-260. In looking at current electrical bills, this changeover would save roughly 30% or \$7,000/year. Unless we need customization, there will be little or no cost for the Town.

***Street Closures: Sam and his crew did an incredible job both in setting up, dismantling, and clean-up.**
