- C. Grant application for police department computers from the WV Dept. of Homeland Security submitted and the Town is waiting on notifications of grant awards made.
- D. Grants for street cameras and traffic calming signs being researched.
- E. Grants for cemetery grave mapping software being researched.
- F. A potential grant for the OnTrac / Main Street program is being researched.
- G. Additional grants for water facility restoration and repair are being researched. Grant applications will be submitted once the final draft of the Professional Engineering Report (PER) is completed.
